UNOPPOSED SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND SURRENDER DATE

Eric Barber, through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Honorable Court to extend his surrender date to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons (“BOP”) from October 1, 2022 to on or after January 2, 2022. The government does not oppose this motion.

Mr. Barber had surgery on or about August 15, 2022. See Exhibit 1 at 1 (to be filed under seal). He requires approximately four additional weeks of physical therapy. *Id.* at 2-4.

In addition, undersigned counsel understands that Mr. Barber has been unable to work for the past several weeks due to the surgery and treatment. As a result, the money he saved up for his family to rely on while he was going to be away has diminished. Mr. Barber requests additional time to replenish his savings for his family to rely on while he is serving his sentence. In light of this and with the winter holidays coming, the defense requests that he report on or after January 2, 2023.
