**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO ENLARGE THE FILING DEADLINE
FOR THE PARTIES’ SENTENCING MEMORANDA**

The United States of America by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully asks this Court for a four-day enlargement of the period in which the parties must file their respective sentencing memoranda. Pursuant to the MINUTE ORDER issued September 9, 2022, “The Parties’ Sentencing Memoranda shall be due on or before November 3, 2022. Replies, if any, shall be due on or before November 10, 2022. Reply briefs shall be limited to five pages. Sentencing for MATTHEW WOOD is set for November 18, 2022, at 2 p.m.” Specifically, the government asks the Court to enlarge the deadline by four days so that parties’ Sentencing Memoranda are due on or before Monday, November 7, 2022. The government *is not* requesting that this Court modify the date for reply briefs, if any, or for any modification of the date or time of the sentencing hearing.

The reason for the request is that although the government has been working diligently on its sentencing memorandum for Wood, it needs two additional business days to finalize the filing and any attachments thereto. The government notified the defense of the filing of this motion, and counsel has no objection to the request. The government is not requesting this further time for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, the government respectfully requests that this Court grant the motion for
