ORDER

Defendant Rachel Marie Powell moves the Court [54] for a modification of her

conditions of release. In particular, she asks that this Court to remove the requirement that she

wear a mask when she leaves her residence. Id. Powell notes that the state of Pennsylvania no

longer has a mask mandate. Id. The government filed a response [55] that took no position on the

issue.

In light of the removal of the mask mandate in her home state—and indeed, every state in

the country but one-the Court will GRANT Powell's motion to modify her conditions of

release. The Court removes the requirement that Powell wear a mask whenever she leaves her

residence.
