This includes desktops, laptops, mobile devices, smart watches, gaming devices, private servers or any other high-speed data-processing device performing logical, arithmetic or storage functions. You must allow the probation officer to conduct initial and periodic unannounced searches of any computers as defined in 18 U.S.C 1030(e)(1) or other electronic communications or data storages devices or media that are subject to computer monitoring. These searches shall be conducted to determine whether the computer contains any prohibited data prior to installation of the monitoring software, whether the monitoring software is functioning effectively after its installation and whether there have been attempts to circumvent the monitoring software after its installation. You must warn any other people who use these computers that the computers may be subject to searches pursuant to this condition.

A probation officer may conduct a search pursuant to this condition only when reasonable suspicion exists that there's a violation of a condition of supervision and that the computer or device contains evidence of this violation. Any search will be conducted at a reasonable time and in a reasonable manner.

You are ordered to make restitution to the Architect of the Capitol in the amount of \$2,000. And you must pay the balance of any restitution owed at a rate of no less than \$75 a month, to commence 30 days after your release from prison.

Restitution payments shall be made to the Clerk of the Court for the United States District Court, District of Columbia, for disbursement.

The Probation Office shall release the presentence investigation report to all appropriate agencies, which includes the United States Probation Office in the approved district of residence, in order to execute the sentence of the Court.
