ORDER

(May 7, 2024)

The Court has been informed that Defendant Daniel Christmann is scheduled to surrender to the Bureau of Prisons on May 7, 2024 (today). Pending before this Court is Mr. Christmann's request for an extension of time in which to surrender due to his pending eviction, which was filed late on May 6, 2024. In light of the eviction proceedings, Mr. Christmann requests that his surrender date be postponed to May 13, 2024. Although Defendant's request was filed as a "Motion," ECF No. 65, it is in the form of a letter, which would normally be rejected by this Court. However, in the interest of not prejudicing Mr. Christmann, the Court will treat such letter as a Motion in this one instance. The Court notes that this matter is particularly time-sensitive insofar as Mr. Christmann is supposed to report in the next hour. Accordingly, it is this 7th day of May 2024,

ORDERED that Mr. Christmann's Motion to Extend his surrender date be GRANTED, and his surrender date should be set for no earlier than May 13, 2024. A copy of this Order will be provided to the United States Marshal's Service.
