First, Defendant indicated that he does not object to the Government's pending 13 Motion to Exclude Time Under The Speedy Trial Act, which moves to exclude time in the interest of justice between April 7, 2021 through the date of Defendant's arraignment, May 3, 2021. Moreover, during the May 3, 2021 hearing, Defendant also consented to the exclusion of time from May 3, 2021, through the date of the next status hearing on June 30, 2021. In light of the foregoing, the Court further finds that a continuance of Defendant's Speedy Trial rights between April 7, 2021 and the date of the next status hearing on June 30, 2021 serves the "ends of justice" and outweighs the best interests of both the community and Defendant in a speedy trial, in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and because the continuance will allow the parties to review discovery and consider plea negotiations, if any. Taking into account this continuance, the Court has calculated that Defendant's new 70-day deadline is SEPTEMBER 8, 2021 .
