It is further ORDERED that (1) the video plea hearing set in this matter for April 11, 2022, at 11:00 a.m., is hereby VACATED and RESCHEDULED as a video status conference for May 10, 2022, at 11:00 a.m.; and (2) time shall be excluded under the ends of justice exception to the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. 3161, from April 11, 2022, until May 10, 2022. The parties represent that "Defendants understand and waive their speedy trial right until May 10, 2022," and that "[t]his request for continuance is not for purposes of delay, but so that justice may be done." Dkt. 53 at 1. The parties further represent that a continuance "will also allow the parties to continue discussing alternative resolutions to this case, potentially short of trial." Id. In light of these representations and the parties' ongoing plea negotiations, the Court finds that the ends of justice served by the continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the Defendants in a speedy trial under 18 U.S.C. 3161(h)(7)(A). To access the status conference, the parties are to use the same Zoom log-in information previously provided by the Deputy Clerk of Court. Signed by Judge Randolph D. Moss on 04/11/2022.
