"The [C]ourt. may" terminate a defendant's probation early "after considering the factors set forth" in 18 U.S.C. 3553(a) "if it is satisfied that such action is warranted by the conduct of the defendant and the interest[s] of justice." 18 U.S.C. 3564(c). As courts in this district have previously held, "good behavior alone" is generally "insufficient to warrant early termination" of probation. See, e.g., United States v. Parker, 219 F. Supp. 3d 183, 191 (D.D.C. 2016) (so holding in the context of supervised release). Upon consideration of the 3553(a) factors, the conduct of the defendant, and the interests of justice, the Court finds that early termination of probation is not warranted at this time. The Court is pleased to see that the defendant has completed her community service, fully complied with the terms of her probation, engaged in productive mental health therapy, and opened a new business. It also credits the defendant's representation that she has "further come to appreciate the wrongful nature of her conduct of conviction." Dkt. 78 at 2. All the same, the defendant's offense -- participation in the January 6 riot -- was exceptionally serious; in view of the nature of the defendant's offense, early termination would not promote respect for the law, provide just punishment, or afford adequate general deterrence. In addition, given the sentences the Court has imposed in similar cases, requiring the defendant to serve only 16 months of probation would create unwarranted sentencing disparities with respect to other, similar defendants. For these reasons, the Court finds that neither the 3553(a) factors nor the interests of justice support early termination of probation. The defendant's motion is therefore DENIED. So Ordered by Judge Dabney L. Friedrich on November 8, 2023. (lcldf1) (Text entry; no document attached.)
