The parties agreed to return for another status hearing on SEPTEMBER 30, 2021 at 1:30 PM, to occur via videoconference with Defendant's consent.	
		During the July 7, 2021 status hearing, the Court discussed Defendant's Speedy Trial rights. Defendant consented to a continuation of those rights between July 7, 2021 and the date of the next status hearing, September 30, 2021. Accordingly, the Court finds that a continuance of Defendant's Speedy Trial rights through September 30, 2021, serves the "ends of justice" and outweighs the interests of both the community and Defendant in a speedy trial, in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and because the continuance will provide Defendant with time to review the voluminous discovery in this case and consider potential plea negotiations. Taking into account this continuance, the 70-day deadline is DECEMBER 9, 2021. The Court finds that the 90-day deadline is inapplicable, given that Defendant is not presently detained pending trial.
