On January 15, 2021, Sacramento SAs Dave Sieber and Aaron Pressnell conducted an interview of Tommy ALLAN at his residence, [REDACTED]. ALLAN initially asked if agents possessed a warrant. Agents advised that they did not have a warrant and that ALLAN was not under arrest and was free to leave. ALLAN ultimately agreed to listen to agents.

Agents explained that the FBI possessed evidence connecting him to the events that unfolded at the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021, specifically that he was observed inside the Capitol building. ALLAN did not deny travelling to Washington DC or entering the Capitol building at any point during the interview. ALLAN expressed interest in talking to a lawyer before answering questions.

ALLAN explained that he and his wife, Holly ALLAN's business, "Toddler Town," had been shut down due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and that he was facing severe financial hardship. In an effort gain cooperation from ALLAN, regarding other conspirators at the Capitol on January 6, SA Sieber offered to contact the U.S. Attorney's Office, Eastern District of California, to secure Defense Counsel for him. ALLAN accepted the offer and confirmed that his home telephone number is [REDACTED].
