UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR WITNESS TO TESTIFY VIRTUALLY

The Defendant, Daniel Egtvedt, by his counsel, Kira Anne West, hereby respectfully asks the Court to allow a witness for the defense, Brother Richard Egtvedt, to testify virtually in the upcoming motion to suppress scheduled for June 2, 2022 in the above case and in support states the following:

This Court will hear a motion to suppress by the defense on June 2, 2022. One of the witnesses for the defense, Brother Richard Egtvedt, lives 3 hours from Washington, D.C. Because of responsibilities at home with the care of his ailing mother, a trip to Washington, D.C. to testify would cause an undue hardship on the family.
