**CONSENT MOTION TO EXTEND TIME BY WHICH TO FILE REPLY**

Aaron James Mileur, through undersigned counsel at the Office of the Federal Public Defender, respectfully moves this Court to continue the time by which counsel must file a Reply to the government's Opposition to Mr. Mileur's Motion to Modify Conditions of Release (Dkt. 101) for two weeks. Assigned counsel, Eugene Ohm, is presently unavailable due to a family emergency. He will file a motion upon his return, in two weeks. In support of this Motion, counsel states:

1. On March 20, 2023, this Court sentenced Mr. Mileur to 24 months' probation following his guilty plea to parading, demonstrating, or picketing, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(G).
2. On March 28, 2023, Mr. Mileur's counsel, Eugene Ohm, filed a motion to modify conditions of probation. Dkt. 101. The government filed its Opposition on April 4, 2023. Dkt. 108. The Court ordered defense counsel to any Reply by April 11, 2023. Minute Order, April 4, 2028.
3. Mr. Ohm intends to file a Reply to the government's Opposition. However, Mr. Ohm is presently unavailable due to a family emergency.

4. Accordingly, undersigned counsel, on behalf of Mr. Ohm respectfully moves the Court to extend the time by which he must file a Reply.
5. The government consents to this request.

Wherefore the reasons herein, counsel moves the Court to permit counsel to Mr. Mileur an additional two weeks to reply to the government's opposition to his motion to modify.
