

Rather, please print and sign this document and, if you concur with the request for a warrant, provide all pages to your Court Room Deputy Clerk who will enter a sealed minute order and process the warrant for service without alerting the public or the offender. After the warrant is executed, the Deputy Clerk will unseal the warrant unless otherwise directed by the Court.

THE COURT ORDERS:

1. Concurs with the recommendation of the Probation Office to *“transfer jurisdiction of Mr. Johnson’s criminal case to the United States District Court for the Northern District of Iowa and allow him to travel internationally to the Dominican Republic from October 30, 2022, through November 8, 2022.”*
2. No action
3. Issuance of a warrant and enter into NCIC and schedule a hearing upon execution
4. Issuance of a summons and schedule a hearing
5. Hearing to modify, revoke, or terminate supervised release shall be held before a magistrate judge for the preparation of a report and recommendation to the district judge. This designation will remain for the duration of the case, and the designated magistrate judge will respond to all subsequent requests from the probation office unless otherwise ordered by the district judge.
