CHRISTIAN DANIEL ("DANIEL"), IN WANT OF COUNSEL, HEREBY  
REQUEST TO TAKE NOTICE OF CONCEPCION v. UNITED STATES, 2022  
U.S. LEXIS 3070 (JUNE 27, 2022):

LIKE DANIEL, CONCEPCION FILED A FIRST STEP ACT MOTION  
AND IN IT NO ONE DISPUTED, IT SENTENCED TODAY, HE WOULD NOT  
BE A CAREER OFFENDER. THE DISTRICT COURT BELIEVED IT HAD  
NO AUTHORITY TO CORRECT THE SENTENCE. THE SUPREME COURT, IN  
CONCEPCION, MADE ONE THING CRYSTAL CLEAR: "[A] FEDERAL  
JUDGE IN DECIDING TO IMPOSE A SENTENCE MAY APPROPRIATELY

CONDUCT AN INQUIRY BROAD IN SCOPE, LARGELY UNLIMITED EITHER AS TO THE KIND OF INFORMATION HE MAY CONSIDER, OR THE SOURCE FROM WHICH IT MAY COME." *Id.* AT \*19 (CITING *UNITED STATES V. TUCKER*, 404 U.S. 443, 446 (1972)). THE VERY HOLDING IN THE CASE SAYS: "THE FIRST STEP ACT ALLOWS DISTRICT COURTS TO CONSIDER INTERVENING CHANGES OF LAW OR FACT IN EXERCISING THEIR DISCRETION TO REDUCE A SENTENCE." *CONCEPCION*, 2022 U.S. LEXIS 3070, AT \*3-4.
