**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

For the reasons stated on the record during the status conference held today, June 15, 2022, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the Federal Detention Center in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (FDC Philadelphia), make Defendant Ryan Samsel available for a video or telephone conference with his attorneys in this case, Stanley Woodward and Juli Haller, within the following time frame:


- Any time after 12:00 PM on Thursday, June 16, 2022; or
- Any time before 10:00 AM on Friday, June 17, 2022; and

**ORDERED** that FDC Philadelphia afford Mr. Samsel at least one hour for this conference with his attorneys. It is further

**ORDERED** that, if FDC Philadelphia does not make Mr. Samsel available for a conference with his attorneys within the time frame stated above, a representative from the facility, and/or the Bureau of Prisons or the United States Marshals Service, shall appear at the status conference scheduled for this Friday, June 17, 2022, at 10:00 AM, via telephone, to show cause as to why the facility was unable to comply with this Order.
