As a result of the family medical situation and counsel's trial schedule, Ms. Borgerdingng requires additional time to review the discovery and consider how to proceed in the case

3. Tolling of the Speedy Trial is in the best interests of Ms. Borgerding and Mr. Messer and

of the public and furthers the interests of justice.

4. Both defendants are released pretrial and are in compliance with the conditions of

release.

Government respectfully requests that the Court continue the Status Conference scheduled for March 31,

2023 for two weeks.
