JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, and the defendant, by and through his attorney, jointly respectfully move this Court for a one-week continuance of sentencing, which is currently scheduled for March 15, 2023.

In support of the motion, the government states that the undersigned counsel for the government will be out of the country from March 13-17, 2023. The United States can arrange for alternate counsel to cover the sentencing but would prefer to have the case's assigned prosecutor handle it.

In support of the motion, defense counsel has not yet submitted his sentencing memorandum and requests a small amount of additional time to complete and file it, while still leaving sufficient time for the Court to review it in advance of sentencing. The defendant is not detained and thus his liberty will not be impacted by the Court granting a short continuance.

The parties jointly request that the Court reschedule sentencing for the **afternoon of March 23, 2023**, if possible. If not, the parties are available whenever it is convenient for the Court except for April 10-18 and May 15-19, 2023, when government counsel will in trial on other cases.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that this Court grant the motion for a one-

week continuance of sentencing.
