GOVERNMENT’S NOTICE OF FILING

On October 27, 2021, the defendant filed under seal a Motion for Revocation of the Detention Order. The government subsequently filed an Opposition to the Defendant’s Motion for Revocation of the Detention Order (“Opposition”), under seal and a redacted version on the public docket. On November 30, 2021, the defendant filed a Reply to the government’s Opposition. On December 6, 2021, the Court ordered the government to submit to the Court relevant video excerpts referenced in its Opposition by December 8, 2021. Accordingly, the government hereby submits the below-described videos to the Court, accessible via USAfx:¹

1. File name: 01282021.0514.usexhibits.pdf
 - a. Description: PowerPoint presentation utilized by the government during the defendant’s January 29, 2021 detention hearing in the Western District of Pennsylvania, consisting of still images and video clips.
2. File name: *D.C. Burning – Jan.6 DC Riots*.mp4
 - a. Description (length: 27:06 minutes): Youtube video, in which the defendant appears standing on a window ledge outside the U.S. Capitol building with a baseball bat in hand and then repeatedly strikes the window until it is knocked out of its frame (12:57-13:40). He breaks out a second window with the bat (13:56-14:00).

¹ These videos, which were previously provided to the defendant in discovery, will also be accessible to the defendant via the same USAfx shared file.

3. File name: Getty Video 1
 - a. Description (length: 1:17 minutes): Defendant appears in the vicinity of the U.S. Capitol Lower West Terrace entrance (“Capitol entrance”) with a flagpole in hand and rubbing his eyes.
4. File name: IMG_9903 – 14 second video
 - a. Description (length: 14 seconds): Defendant appears outside the Capitol entrance with a flagpole in hand and spits at officers guarding doorway, moments after a rioter sprays officers with fire extinguisher and another rioter throws a shield at officers.
5. File name: *Dozens arrested as the manhunt for persons involved in Capitol siege ramps up*.mp4 – GMA
 - a. Description (length: 3:38 minutes): GMA news report, in which the defendant appears outside the Capitol entrance and strikes officers, who are guarding the doorway in riot gear, repeatedly with a flagpole (00:53-00:59).
6. File name: LowerWTerraceDoorExterior_2021-01-06_video footage
 - a. Description (length: 18:37 minutes): Surveillance video in which the defendant appears at the Capitol entrance and engages in repeated assaultive conduct directed toward the police officers guarding the entrance (4:10 to 5:20) – including throwing a large rectangular-shaped cone (4:10), spitting (4:24), throwing a large white object (4:28), throwing a stick or flagpole. The defendant steps away from the doorway and interacts with another rioter, possibly engaging in a minor altercation (5:22-:31). The defendant reappears and continues to engage in assaultive conduct directed toward the officers (5:41-6:07 and 7:00-7:10) – including throwing an object, possibly a long pole or post attached to a rectangular stand (6:07) and then striking the officers repeatedly with a pole (7:00 to 7:10).
7. File name: *I Can’t Breathe (On the Steps)/The Storm Arrived Pt. 9*.mp4
 - a. Description (length: 5:11 minutes): YouTube video, in which the defendant appears outside a window to the U.S. Capitol and repeatedly strikes it with baseball bat (2:46-3:35), and then crawls into the Capitol through a broken window (3:53).
8. File name: *I Can’t Breathe 1776/The Storm Arrived Pt. 10*.mp4
 - a. Description (length: 3:38 minutes): YouTube video, in which the defendant appears throughout the video at the U.S. Capitol window he had previously broken out. Highlights include the defendant filming the crowd with a red cell phone (:14-:25), taking possession of a chair from another rioter through the broken window and passing it to the crowd outside the Capitol (2:28), taking possession of a flagpole from another rioter through the broken window (2:53), and waving two flags (an American flag and a Trump flag) from while standing on the window ledge, as the crowd chants “1776” (3:10-3:18).
9. File name: *I Can’t Breathe Traitor/The Storm Arrived Pt. 11*.mp4
 - a. Description (length: 3:20 minutes): YouTube video, in which the defendant appears on the above-described window ledge and repeatedly strikes a second
