**ORDER**

This matter having come before the Court pursuant to a Motion to Continue, upon consent, it is therefore

ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED; it is further

ORDERED that the currently scheduled preliminary hearing on December 28, 2021, shall be vacated for good cause due to the parties' joint request to waive the matter; it is further

ORDERED that the currently scheduled status hearing on December 28, 2021, shall be continued for good cause to March 1, 2022 at 1:00 p.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that the time from December 28, 2021 through March 1, 2022, shall be excluded from calculation under the Speedy Trial Act. The Court finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of such continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and Defendant in a speedy trial, as the continuance will provide the parties with additional time to review discovery materials and engage in a pretrial resolution of this matter.
