UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF MARCH 17, 2023 STATUS HEARING

The United States respectfully requests the Court continue the status hearing, presently set

18, 2023, would be in the interests of justice.

WHEREFORE, the Government respectfully moves to continue the status hearing and toll

time under the Speedy Trial Act until the date of the next hearing, either April 17, 2023 or April

18, 2023.
