Proposed Order

Upon consideration of the representations made by the parties in the September 20, 2022 joint status report, it is hereby ORDERED that pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4241(b) the defendant be evaluated by Dr. Shawn Roberson, a licensed psychologist for the purpose of a forensic screening of the defendant's competency, and that after such examination a report be made to this Court and the parties, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4247(c), as to whether the defendant is presently mentally competent to understand the nature and consequences of the proceedings against him and to properly assist in the preparation of his defense.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that defendant undergo an assessment by Dr. Roberson as to whether defendant suffered from any mental disease or defect affecting his sanity at the time of the offense pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4242. After such assessment, Dr. Roberson shall include in a report, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4247(c), his opinion as to whether, at the time of the acts constituting the offense, the defendant was unable to appreciate the nature and quality or the wrongfulness of his or her acts as a result of a severe mental disease or defect.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Assistant United States Attorney assigned to this matter shall immediately submit the paperwork necessary to ensure the timely payment for the reports.
