JOINT MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF STATUS HEARING

The United States of America, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, and Mr. Landon Mitchell, by and through his attorney, Dani Jahn, Esquire (collectively, "the parties") jointly move this Court to continue the Status Hearing currently scheduled for April 22, 2022.

On December 16, 2021, the parties appeared before this Court whereby the parties advised that discovery was on-going. Upon request from the defense, this Court excluded time under the Speedy Trial Act until February 25, 2022. *See* Minute Order, dated 12/16/21.

On February 22, 2022, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Continue the previously scheduled status hearing set for February 25, 2022, which was granted by this Court on the same day. *See* Minute Order, dated 2/22/22.

Since that filing, discovery continues to be provided. Further, the parties have been in discussions about a pretrial disposition in this matter. Therefore, the parties agree that it is in the interest of justice to continue those discussions and thus request an exclusion of time under the Speedy Trial Act pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).

Accordingly, the parties request a continuance of approximately 60 to 90 days and an exclusion of time under the Speedy Trial Act until that date.
