**ORDER**

**MODIFYING VIC WILLIAMS' CONDITIONS OF RELEASE**

It is hereby **ORDERED** that Defendant Vic Williams' Motion to Modify Conditions of Release (ECF No. 13), is **GRANTED**. Mr. Williams has moved to modify the conditions of his release to accommodate the travel requirements of his current employment, which requires travel on short notice outside of Texas. The Government does not oppose the motion. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Mr. Williams will remain generally subject to the current conditions of his release, which mandate that he notify the Western District of Texas (Midland-Odesa) in advance of any and all travel outside of the Western and Southern Districts of Texas. However, in a situation where he receives less than 24 hours' notice from his employer that he is required to travel for work-related purposes and it is not feasible to provide pretrial services with advanced notice, he may notify them within 24 hours of his arrival at the out-of-district work location. The restrictions on Mr. Williams' travel to Washington D.C. (with the exception of Court proceedings) remains in effect.
