**DEFENDANT’S MOTION FOR RETURN OF PASSPORT & CLARIFICATION OF
SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION**

Mr. Phillip Weisbecker, through his attorney, Kira Anne West, respectfully requests that this Honorable Court order the return of his passport and clarification of various conditions of probation and states the following in support:

Argument

The defendant appeared before this Court for sentencing on June 27, 2022. The return of the defendant’s passport was not ordered and because he needs it for work, and because he otherwise has a right to his passport, the defense requests that the Court order it returned. Undersigned counsel spoke to pretrial services officer Angela Fisk of San Diego, CA pretrial services who stated a motion and Court order was necessary for her to return it.

Further, it was defense counsel’s understanding that the Court ordered that the defendant could have his firearm back and not be drug tested. Undersigned counsel received an email today from PO Sherry Baker who presided at the sentencing and she indicated in her email that she did not believe that the Court ordered mandatory drug testing. Finally, the defendant asks that this Court change his oral order of weekends of incarceration to a straight 30 days with credit for 7 days time served.
