Pursuant to an arrest warrant issued on September 30, 2021 by Magistrate Judge Robin M. Meriweather of the United States (U.S.) District Court for the District of Columbia, FBI Special Agents (SA) arrested Darrell Neely (NEELY) on October 18, 2021 at the FBI Washington Field Office (WFO), [REDACTED], Washington, DC 20535.

[Agent Note: This interview was audio recorded. The recording will be submitted to WFO Evidence. The recording stands as the official record of the interview.]

While being processed at WFO, NEELY was advised of his rights via the FBI FD-395 "Advice of Rights" form by SA [REDACTED]. NEELY agreed to speak with law enforcement and signed the FD-395. Following NEELY waving his rights, FBI SA [REDACTED] and SA [REDACTED] conducted a consensual interview of NEELY. NEELY provided the following information:

On January 6, 2021, NEELY was at the United States Capitol and went inside via the left of center entrance. While inside the Capitol NEELY found and picked up a U.S. Capitol Police jacket, a U.S. Capitol Police hat and a bandage package. NEELY kept the velcro strap from the jacket and the hat. NEELY gave the jacket to an officer as he was exiting the Capitol. NEELY did not take any china plates.

NEELY left the hat at an apartment on 28th, but was unsure of the exact address. NEELY left the velcro strap on his dresser at his mother's residence. NEELY stated "It's not stealing, it's memorabilia."

NEELY did not do any drugs inside the Capitol beside smoking a cigarette. NEELY talked to an unknown female inside the Capitol wearing white leggings. The female knew too many people there. NEELY talked to an unknown male inside with four stars and also saw the male with the horns walking down the

hallway. While inside the Capitol NEELY went by an office with a bookshelf, that had people inside. The room looked similar to a media room. Three of the people inside the room were giving directions to people.

NEELY filmed and broadcast over his network while inside the Capitol.

After the Capitol, NEELY went to Georgetown to eat dinner and then went home to his ex-wife's residence.
