As part of its ruling, the Court outlined the four Bail Reform Act factors, 18 U.S.C. § 3142(g)(1)-(4), explaining in detail their applicability to the Courts finding that no condition or combination of conditions could reasonably assure the safety of any person or the community. The transcript of the December 30, 2021 hearing shall serve as this Courts written findings of fact and a written statement of the reasons for the detention. 18 U.S.C. § 3142(i)(1); see also United States v. Peralta, 849 F.2d 625, 626 (D.C. Cir. 1988) (holding that the transcription of a detention hearing, if it evinces a clear and legally sufficient basis for the court's determination, will satisfy the requirements of [18 U.S.C. §] 3142(i)).
