BOOKING ORDER

Upon a representation by the United States that the defendant has never been subject to "routine processing" (booking, fingerprinting, photographing, etc.) in this case;

It is this 6th day of December, 2021, **ORDERED**:

That if the defendant is released on bond that he or she be accompanied by an agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to the FBI's Chicago Field Office for "routine processing," and that this be a condition of being released on bond, and that the "routine processing" must occur in December 2021 absent further order of the Court;

That if the defendant is not released on bond, the United States Marshal shall release the defendant to the custody of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the purpose of "routine processing" and at the conclusion thereof the defendant shall be returned to the custody of the U.S. Marshal.
