ORDER

Upon consideration of the Defendant's health and in the interest of justice, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the United States Marshals Service **STAY** Defendant's removal to the District of Columbia. Defendant must remain at the detention facility he is currently housed. It is further

ORDERED that if the Government believes it is in the interest of justice to transfer Defendant to the District of Columbia, the Government must file a motion requesting Defendant's transfer and explaining the basis for the request.
