**GOVERNMENT’S POST-SENTENCING MOTION TO DISMISS REMAINING
COUNTS ON THE INDICTMENT**

The plea agreement signed by the parties and accepted by the Court on February 16, 2023, contains the following language:

In consideration of your client’s guilty plea to the above offense, your client will not be further prosecuted criminally by this Office for the conduct set forth in the attached Statement of Offense. The government will request that the Court dismiss the remaining counts of the Indictment in this case at the time of sentencing. Your client agrees and acknowledges that the charges to be dismissed at the time of sentencing were based in fact.

ECF No. 39, ¶ 4. The defendant’s sentencing hearing took place on Tuesday, July 11, 2023. The government now asks the Court to dismiss all remaining counts of the Indictment. Specifically, pursuant to the plea agreement, the government asks this Court to dismiss Count One, Count Two, Count Four, Count Five, Count Six, Count Seven, Count Eight, and Count Nine.
