My name is Keith Lints, Luke Lints is my oldest son.

In the 1990's, I was an applicant for employment with the state of Michigan for a maintenance position. Within the employment application, there was an assessment of personal compassion. 
Steve told me that he thinks Luke was assisting in "Keeping the Peace", and should receive the "Congressional Medal of Honor" for his actions.
