UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO
CONTINUE SENTENCING

The United States of America (the "government") hereby moves this Court to continue sentencing, current set for November 29, 2022, at 3:15 EST. See 10/07/22 Minute Order. In support of this motion, the undersigned states as follows:

The government's counsel was previously scheduled for jury trial in front of Judge Mehta starting November 1, 2022, in *U.S. v. Peter Schwartz, et al.* See Case No. 1:21-cr-178(APM), at ECF No. 72. However, that Court is currently involved in another jury trial which has continued past our original starting date. At a pretrial conference on October 21, 2022, Judge Mehta informed the parties that the *Schwartz* matter would be continued to begin jury selection on November 22, 2022, and the government's case to begin on November 29, 2022. The government expects that case to take approximately 3-5 days.


In addition, government's counsel is scheduled for a bench trial in front of Judge Nichols on December 8, 2022, in *United States v. Garret Miller.* See Case No. 1:21-cr-119(CJN), 10/18/22 Minute Order.

The government has conferred with counsel for Mr. Johnson, and he is unopposed to the government's motion.

WHEREFORE, the United States respectfully requests that this Court continue Mr. Johnson's sentencing to a later date.
