## MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING MEMORANDUM DEADLINE

The United States of America hereby moves this Court to extend the deadline to file the government's sentencing memorandum from March 1, 2023, to March 6, 2023. In support of the motion, the United States provides that:

- 1. A sentencing hearing is set for March 13, 2023, in this case.
- 2. The government is the process of finalizing the sentencing memorandum currently due to be filed on March 1, 2023.
- 3. The undersigned counsel will be out of the country without access to Department of Justice internal network systems and email from February 25, 2023, until March 5, 2023.
- 4. A small amount of time will be needed to make final revisions to the sentencing memorandum once the undersigned counsel returns from outside the country on March 5, 2023.
- 5. The undersigned counsel did not have an opportunity to consult with opposing counsel prior to filing this motion. However, an extension of time will not be prejudicial to the defendant, and the government would be in favor of extending the deadline for the defendant's sentencing memorandum to the same date.
