MOTION TO SET RULE 11 HEARING

The United States of America requests to cancel the status hearing, set for October 19, 2021, and for the Court to set a Rule 11 hearing date approximately 7 to 14 business days after October 19, 2021, or to a date convenient for the Court. As grounds for the motion, the government states:

On May 5, 2021, the United States filed an Information, charging the defendant with: (1) entering and remaining in a restricted building or grounds, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1752(a)(1); (2) disorderly and disruptive conduct in a restricted building or grounds, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1752(a)(2); (3) disorderly conduct in a Capitol building, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(D); (4) parading, demonstrating, or picketing in a Capitol building, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(G); and (5) climbing on U.S. Capitol Grounds, in violation of 40 U.S.C. § 5104(d).

At this time, the parties would request a Rule 11 hearing date. The parties would request additional time to finalize the paperwork and submit the paperwork in advance of the date set by the Court. The government would further request that the Court exclude the period from October 19, 2021 to the date for the Rule 11 Hearing, finding that the ends of justice served by excluding the period of this continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy

trial, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A).

The defendant assents to the motion.
