**Unopposed Motion to Permit Travel for Business Conference**

Iraj Javid, by and through counsel, respectfully requests that this Court permit him to travel to Orlando, Florida for a business conference between April 14 and April 17, 2023. In support of this Motion, Mr. Javid states the following facts.

1. Mr. Javid was arrested on a complaint on March 3, 2022. He was ordered released on his own personal recognizance. On August 12, 2022 Mr. Javid pled guilty to the misdemeanor offense of parading, demonstrating, or picketing in the Capitol.
2. On February 3, 2023, this Court sentenced Mr. Javid to 24 months of probation to include 90 days of home detention. The Court ordered that “[f]or the period of home detention, he shall remain at his place of residence, except for employment, education, religious services, medical or substance abuse or mental health treatment, attorney visits, court appearances, court obligations or other activities approved in advance by the Probation Office.” (ECF No. 35). Mr. Javid has now served more than 60 days of that 90 day home detention term without incident.

3. Mr. Javid and his wife operate a small Amway business and prior to sentencing in this case he had purchased airline tickets to attend a conference in Orlando, Florida scheduled for April 14-16, 2023. He seeks permission to attend this conference as originally planned.
4. Counsel for Mr. Javid has discussed this request with Mr. Javid's Probation Officer and the assigned Assistant United States Attorney. Neither objects to this request.

**Conclusion**

For the reasons set forth above, Mr. Javid respectfully requests that this motion be granted and that the Court permit him to travel to the Florida to attend the business conference between April 14 and 17, 2023.
