NOW COMES, defendant, Tyler Tew, by and through his undersigned counsel, William L. Shipley, requesting this Honorable Court to continue the Status Conference currently scheduled for June 24, 2022, at 1:30 pm.

Attorney Shipley is set to appear in a multi-defendant Status Conference in the “Oathkeeper” case, U.S. v. Rhodes, 22-cr-15, before the Hon. Amit Mehta, at 1:00 pm on June 24, and it is unlikely that hearing will conclude prior to the 1:30 pm start time for the Status Conference in this case.

Attorney Shipley conferred with Counsel for the Government – who also has a time-conflict on June 24 – and both agreed that they would seek the Court’s approval to move the Status Conference in this case approximately two weeks, or to whatever date the Court determines to be available on its calendar.
