ORDER

Based upon the representations in the Unopposed Motion to Continue and to Exclude Time Under the Speedy Trial Act, and upon consideration of the entire record, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion is **GRANTED**; it is further

ORDERED that the currently scheduled preliminary hearing on April 12, 2022, be continued for good cause to May 26, 2022 at 1:00 p.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that the time between April 12, 2022 and May 26, 2022, will be excluded from the calculation under the Speedy Trial Act, *see* to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). The Court finds that the ends of justice served by granting of such a continuance outweighs the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial, as a continuance will provide the parties additional time to negotiate a potential pretrial resolution and additional time to review discovery.
