DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO WAIVE JURY TRIAL

(ECF No. 1.). A jury trial on these charges is scheduled to begin before this Court on February 21, 2023. After considering his rights, Mr. Ramey wishes to waive his right to a jury trial and proceed with a bench trial on February 21, 2023.

WHEREFORE, Mr. Ramey respectfully requests the Court to grant his motion and proceed in this matter with a bench trial under Fed. R. Crim. P. 23.
