Today, counsel communicated with Mr. Todd by both telephone and text. He is doing well. Mr. Todd discussed obtaining a release form from his VA doctor during his appointment yesterday, and counsel is going to provide transportation for Mr. Todd to travel to the VA office tomorrow to obtain the release. Mr. Todd continues to receive home visits by pre-trial without incident. Counsel also spoke with Missouri pre-trial services officer Brian Graham today by telephone. He confirmed that there are no issues with Mr. Todd at this point and that he would let me know if there was anything he needed from me. We also discussed that I will coordinate transportation for Mr. Todd to and from the pre-trial services office as needed early next week. Counsel also left a voicemail for DC pre-trial services officer Christine Schuck today. He wanted to confirm that everything was good from her standpoint and that she had received the e-mail counsel sent yesterday confirming the name of the second proposed custodian, Kyle Revels.
