GOVERNMENT’S NOTICE OF FILING OF EXHIBITS
PURUSANT TO LOCAL CRIMINAL RULE 49

The United States of America, through the undersigned, hereby gives this notice pursuant to Local Criminal Rule 49, of the following exhibits that were entered into evidence during the sentencing hearing that took place on April 10, 2023. As the United States stated on the record during the sentencing proceeding, it is the government’s position that these should be released to the public. Because the exhibits are video clips, they are not in a format that readily permits electronic filing on CM/ECF.

The proposed exhibits are as follows:

1. Government Exhibit 1 is a video approximately 2 minutes and 30 seconds in length that portrays the fire door entrance to a hallway of the U.S. Senate adjoining the Senate Parliamentarian’s Office of the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021.
2. Government Exhibit 2 is a video approximately 8 minutes and 56 seconds in length that portrays the entrance surrounding the Senate Wing Door of the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021.
3. Government Exhibit 3 is a video from the device of another rioter who was livestreaming. The clip is approximately 5 minutes in length and portrays this rioter’s travel from

the lobby area surrounding the Senate Wing Door to the office of U.S. Senator Jeffrey Merkley on January 6, 2021.
