ORDER

Based upon the representation in the Consent Motion to Continue and to Exclude Time Under the Speedy Trial Act, and upon consideration of the entire record, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion ^{is Part} is ~~is~~ GRANTED; it is further ORDERED that the currently scheduled status conference on August 4, 2023, ^{is denied as moot} be ~~continued for good cause to October 3, 2023~~ at ~~12:30 p.m.~~; and it further

ORDERED that the time between August 4, 2023, and October 3, 2023, shall be excluded from calculation under the Speedy Trial Act, see 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). The Court finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of such a continuance outweighs the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial, as a continuance will provide that parties additional time to continue negotiating a potential resolution and will allow that parties additional time to review discovery.

ORDERED that the current status conference set for August 4, 2023, be continued to October 3, 2023, at 12:30 p.m.
