**THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA'S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT
BENJAMIN SCOTT ROBINSON'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO MODIFY
CONDITIONS OF RELEASE**

The United States of America does not oppose Defendant Benjamin Scott Robinson's Emergency Motion to Modify Conditions of Release. The Government has conferred with U.S. Pretrial Services regarding Defendant reporting in his Motion that Pretrial Services has told him that he is not allowed to move his residence.
