APPEARANCE BOND

Defendant's Agreement

I, ZACHARY JOHNSON (defendant), agree to follow every order of this court, or any court that considers this case, and I further agree that this bond may be forfeited if I fail:

- (X) to appear for court proceedings;
(X) if convicted, to surrender to serve a sentence that the court may impose; or
(X) to comply with all conditions set forth in the Order Setting Conditions of Release.

Forfeiture or Release of the Bond

Forfeiture of the Bond. This appearance bond may be forfeited if the defendant does not comply with the above agreement. At the request of the United States, the court may order a judgment of forfeiture against the defendant and each surety for the entire amount of the bond, including interest and costs.

Release of the Bond. The court may order this appearance bond ended at any time. This bond will be satisfied and the security will be released when either: (1) the defendant is found not guilty on all charges, or (2) the defendant reports to serve a sentence.

CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

1. Defendant must appear in court as required and, if convicted, must surrender as directed to serve a sentence that the court may impose.
2. Defendant must advise the United States Pretrial Services or supervising officer in writing before making any change of residence or telephone number.
3. Defendant must not, at any time, for any reason whatsoever, leave the Middle District of Florida without first obtaining written permission of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, Tampa Division.
4. Defendant must not violate federal, state, or local law while on release.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF DEFENDANT'S RELEASE:

- a. Defendant shall submit to supervision by and report for supervision to the United States Pretrial Services as directed by the United States Pretrial Services or supervising officer once per week.
- b. Defendant shall not obtain a passport or other international travel document.
- c. Defendant may travel to the District of Columbia to/for court proceedings, attorney visits only. Prior to any travel, Defendant must notify the United States Pretrial Services of the date of travel, travel itinerary, and the specific address of residence within the District of Columbia.
- d. Defendant shall report to the District of Columbia, via Zoom Video on January 20, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. for proceedings in that district. Prior to any travel, Defendant must notify the United States Pretrial Services of the date of travel, travel itinerary, and the specific address of residence within the District of Columbia.
- e. Defendant shall not possess a firearm, destructive device, or other weapon.
- f. Defendant shall continue employment.
- g. Defendant shall participate in the following location restriction program and comply with its requirements as directed.

- Home Detention: Defendant is restricted to his residence at all times except for employment; medical, attorney visits; court appearances; court-ordered obligations; or other activities approved in advance by the United States Pretrial Services or supervising officer. Defendant's compliance shall be monitored as directed by the United States Pretrial Services or supervising officer by GPS.
- h. Defendant shall report as soon as possible, to the United States Pretrial Services or supervising officer, every contact with law enforcement personnel, including arrests, questioning, or traffic stops.

ADVICE OF PENALTIES AND SANCTIONS

Defendant is advised of the following penalties and sanctions:

Violating any of the foregoing conditions of release may result in the immediate issuance of a warrant for your arrest, a revocation of your release, an order of detention, a forfeiture of any bond, and a prosecution for contempt of court and could result in imprisonment, a fine, or both.

While on release, if you commit a federal felony offense the punishment is an additional prison term of not more than ten years and for a federal misdemeanor offense the punishment is an additional prison term of not more than one year. This sentence will be consecutive (i.e., in addition to) to any other sentence you receive.

It is a crime punishable by up to ten years in prison, and a \$250,000 fine, or both, to: obstruct a criminal investigation; tamper with a witness, victim, or informant; retaliate or attempt to retaliate against a witness, victim, or informant; or intimidate or attempt to intimidate a witness, victim, juror, informant, or officer of the court. The penalties for tampering, retaliation, or intimidation are significantly more serious if they involve a killing or attempted killing.

If, after release, you knowingly fail to appear as the conditions of release require, or to surrender to serve a sentence, you may be prosecuted for failing to appear or surrender and additional punishment may be imposed. If you are convicted of:

- (1) an offense punishable by death, life imprisonment, or imprisonment for a term of fifteen years or more – you will be fined not more than \$250,000 or imprisoned for not more than 10 years, or both;
- (2) an offense punishable by imprisonment for a term of five years or more, but less than fifteen years – you will be fined not more than \$250,000 or imprisoned for not more than five years, or both;
- (3) any other felony – you will be fined not more than \$250,000 or imprisoned not more than two years, or both;

- (4) a misdemeanor – you will be fined not more than \$100,000 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

A term of imprisonment imposed for failure to appear or surrender will be consecutive to any other sentence you receive. In addition, a failure to appear or surrender may result in the forfeiture of any bond posted.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE DEFENDANT

I acknowledge that I am the defendant in this case and that I am aware of the conditions of release. I promise to obey all conditions of release, to appear as directed, and surrender to serve any sentence imposed. I am aware of the penalties and sanctions set forth above.
