## <u>ORDER</u>

Defendant Dylan R. Cronin has moved to extend the date on which he is to self-surrender to the Bureau of Prisons. [Dkt. # 95]. The motion is unopposed, and given the defendant's acceptance of responsibility and compliance with his conditions of release, the motion is **GRANTED**. Therefore, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the date for the defendant's self-surrender will be extended until **January 3**, **2024** or any date thereafter as determined by the Bureau of Prisons. The defendant must selfsurrender for service of the sentence at the institution and on the date designated by the Bureau of Prisons as notified by the Pretrial Services Agency or U.S. Probation Office.
