CONSENT MOTION TO MOVE TIME OF SENTENCE

Earlier this week, at the request of counsel, a Continuance of Sentence was Granted, to permit the Office of U.S. Probation sufficient time to conduct a PreSentence Interview of the defendant. The Court granted the Motion and Continued the matter to October 21, 2022 at 1:00 P.M..
