UNOPPOSED MOTION TO MODIFY CONDITIONS OF PRETRIAL RELEASE

Matthew Huttle, through his attorney Andrew Hemmer of the Federal Defender Program for the Northern District of Illinois, files this motion to modify his conditions of pretrial release to allow him to relocate to the Western District of Arkansas and for his pretrial courtesy supervision to be transferred from the District of Idaho to the Western District of Arkansas. In support, Mr. Huttle states as follows:

1. Mr. Huttle's Order Setting Conditions of Release (OSCR) was entered on or about December 8, 2022. Mr. Huttle currently resides in the District of Idaho and thus the OSCR provided that Mr. Huttle would "receive and comply with courtesy supervision from the District of Idaho."

2. Mr. Huttle's employment in the District of Idaho as a contractor was projectbased and the project(s) he was working on there have now concluded. Mr. Huttle was able to find similar work in Arkansas and desires to relocate there so he can work.

3. The undersigned and Mr. Huttle communicated with the D.C. Pretrial Services Officer assigned to Mr. Huttle's case and her attempts to transfer courtesy supervision from the District of Idaho to the Western District of Arkansas without a court order were unsuccessful, apparently due to the provision in the OSCR that courtesy supervision would be in the District of

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Idaho.

4. Accordingly, Mr. Huttle requests that the Court modify his OSCR to allow him to relocate to the Western District of Arkansas immediately and for his pretrial courtesy supervision to be transferred from the District of Idaho to the Western District of Arkansas.

Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the government and D.C.
Pretrial Services and neither the government nor D.C. Pretrial Services opposes the requested relief.

Accordingly, Mr. Matthew Huttle respectfully requests that the Court modify his conditions of pretrial release as set forth above, and for such other relief as the Court deems reasonable and just.
