**ORDER**

This matter having come before the Court pursuant to a Defendant’s Unopposed Motion to Continue and to Exclude Time Under the Speedy Trial Act (Dkt. No. 19), it is therefore:

ORDERED that the complaint and previous order of pre-trial release with conditions of supervised release remain in full force and effect; it is further

ORDERED that the motion (Dkt. No. 19) is GRANTED; it is further

ORDERED that the preliminary hearing scheduled for April 27, 2023, is continued until May 11, 2023, at 1:00 PM before United States Magistrate Judge Zia M. Faruqui; and it is further

ORDERED that the period of time between April 27, 2023, and May 11, 2023, shall be excluded from computing time under the Speedy Trial Act, including the time within which an information or indictment must be filed, because the ends of justice served by such a continuance outweigh the interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. See 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(1) & (h)(7). The Court finds that the parties are working in good faith to prepare for the preliminary hearing and in exploring pretrial resolutions.
