UNOPPOSED MOTION TO MODIFY CURFEW HOURS

COMES NOW Defendant, Farbod Francis Azari, by and through undersigned counsel and pursuant to Rules of Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, to modify the curfew from 9 pm – 6 am to 11 pm to 6 am. The Defendant is currently being supervised by Pretrial Services, Shania Fennell.

1. Amongst other conditions (See Court Docket Entry 10), the Defendant is required to maintain certain curfew restrictions – from 9 pm to 6 am, daily.
2. The Defendant is self-employed as a real estate business person and does not work the typical 9 to 5 pm job.
3. The required curfew of 9 pm has caused Defendant additional stress as he is required to be home by 9 pm.
4. Occasionally, Defendant must attend evening business meetings, and he cannot do so with a 9 pm curfew.
5. Undersigned discussed this matter with the Assigned Assistant United States Attorney, Kyle McWaters, and the Government has consented to modify the curfew from 11 pm to 6 am.

6. As referenced in Docket Entry 10, the Defendant has not had substantial violations since being placed with Pretrial Services on January 26, 2023.
