**DEFENDANT’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO APPEAL THE
MAGISTRATE’S MARCH 25 ORDER COMPELLING PAYMENT TO
THE COURT REGISTRY**

Pursuant to Rule 45 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, Defendant Jeremy Brown, by and through undersigned counsel, moves this Court for an extension of time to appeal the Magistrate’s March 25 Order compelling payment of \$12,300.00 to the Court Registry. Mr. Brown requests fourteen (14) days to file an appeal from the time the transcript of the March 25, 2022 hearing is filed with the Court. As grounds for this motion, Defendant states that:

1. On March 25, 2022, the magistrate judge orally ordered that that certain trust funds were available to Mr. Brown, and he was required to deposit \$12,300.00 into the Court’s registry by April 1, 2022 or be held in criminal contempt.

2. Mr. Brown took out an unsecured loan to avoid being held in contempt and paid \$12,300.00 into the registry on April 1, 2022. (Doc. 145).
3. The magistrate then purged Mr. Brown of the order of contempt. (Doc. 146).
4. Undersigned counsel and the government have both ordered the transcript of the March 25, 2022 hearing. The transcript has not been completed.

WHEREFORE, Defendant moves this Court for an order granting an extension of time in which to file an appeal of the magistrate judge's order. Mr. Brown requests fourteen (14) days from the date that the transcript of the March 25, 2022 hearing is filed with the Court to file his appeal.
