**ORDER ON UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE
AND AMENDMENTS OF BOND CONDITIONS**

This matter having come before the Court pursuant to a Motion for Continuance and Amendments of Bond Conditions, and upon consideration of the entire record, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the Motion is GRANTED; it is further

ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for April 9, 2024, is continued to May 2, 2024, at 1:00 PM; and it is further

ORDERED that the period of time between April 9, 2024, and May 2, 2024, shall be excluded from computing time under the Speedy Trial Act because the ends of justice served by such a continuance outweigh the interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(1) & (h)(7). The Court finds that the parties are working in good faith towards a potential resolution, and that delay is necessary for the parties to review discovery and work towards an agreement for pretrial disposition of the case; and it is further

ORDERED that part (7)(f) of the defendant's Order Setting Conditions of Release be amended to allow defendant to travel in the Northern District of Texas for the purposes of visiting defendant's mother and meeting with defendant's attorney without advanced notification to Pretrial Services Agency (PSA) in the Eastern District of Texas/Plano; and it is further

ORDERED that part (7)(g) of the defendant's Order Setting Conditions of Release be amended to allow defendant to have contact with her daughter, Kailey Nemeth, but they must not discuss the events of January 6, 2021, nor any subsequent investigation or prosecution.
