ORDER

Defendant Michael Daniele filed a Motion for a Bill of Particulars on January 15, 2024, ECF No. 28. The United States failed to respond to Defendant’s motion within 14 days. Accordingly, the court grants Defendant’s motion as conceded. *See* LCrR 47(b) (setting a 14-day deadline to file an opposition brief and providing that, “[i]f such memorandum is not filed within the prescribed time, the Court may treat the motion as conceded”).

The court hereby orders that by February 19, 2024, the United States shall provide Defendant with a bill of particulars that identifies the acts that it alleges constituted: (1) conduct “to obstruct, impede, and interfere with law enforcement officers,” both at the Peace Circle (Count One) and the West Plaza (Count Two), 18 U.S.C. § 231(a)(3), and (2) “disorderly or disruptive conduct” within a restricted building or grounds or at any place in the Grounds or in any of the Capitol Buildings (Counts Four and Five), 18 U.S.C. § 1752(a)(2), 40 U.S.C. § 5104(e)(2)(D). *See* Superseding Indictment, ECF No. 23.
